  - Budget Report

6. Presidents Report Mark

  - Redistricting
    - Last week board meeting went till 12:20 a.m.
    - School board did not accept map 6 – mill street would remain overcrowded in this plan.
    - Will be discussed again at next board meeting
    - If parent(s) ask what the NUEA is doing...direct them to Mark...we will provide a top-notch, world class education regardless of building.
  - All Day Kindergarten
    - Will cost about \$2 million more in staffing, have talk about spending \$1 million in Chinese immersion.
    - \$7 million to upgrade buildings
  - ICC
    - Not impacting HS IC's...may be positions coming down the road at that level
    - Question raised about how come have money for coaches but not for a full-time assistant principal. There is a need for more admin support due to behavior issues that are rising. May be a topic for IPC.
  - SB 7 Team meeting
    - 4 Levels of rating need to be in place this fall.
    - Mark is pushing for new rubrics for all certified staff based on their job description.
    - As of today, the training for admins is still not in place to be ready for September roll out.
  - IEA Convention
    - Coming up in 2 weeks
    - Question asked about possible increase in dues...due to membership lost alone an increase is needed.
  - NEA Convention Washington DC June 30 – July 5
