- Global Scholar
  - Pinnacle Instruction district assessments
  - Pinnacle Analytics view of data to look at different data side by side
  - It does have a gradebook feature but we are not changing anything for next year.
  - o Go live 3<sup>rd</sup> trimester for Elementary & Jr. High and Finals for High school
- Redistricting
  - Board Meeting is being held at KJHS this evening
  - NUEA is currently staying out of this issue
  - Only guaranteed a job in the district for which they are certified for, not a specific school/grade
- All Day Kindergarten
  - One of the last large districts to not have all day kindergarten
- Chinese immersion

- Similar to the Spanish program
- o Didn't happen last time around b/c 1) lack of interest 2) cost of program
- ICC Design meetings
  - Have a job description to be vetted by principals
  - o Feb 15 for principal, Feb 16 for current ICCs
  - Will be creating positions at some levels, redefining positions at others
- SB 7 Team meeting
  - o Had 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting
  - There are some timelines b/c of the law
    - By 9/1 principals /evaluators have to pass a test to evaluate
    - By fall 4 new categories have to be in place
      - There will be 4 new categories: excellent, sufficient, needs improvement, unsatisfactory
  - o New rif categories: Seniority, Overall Rating, Certifications, tenure/non-tenure
  - o If you have 3 years of Excellent as a non-tenured teacher can become tenured in 3 years
  - o Tenure is now portable which can mean less time gaining tenure in a new district
  - Also going to take the time to evaluate the whole evaluation process to look for those positions that may have been tweaked into an evaluation model that doesn't really fit.
  - 2016 is when student progress is tied to evaluation
  - o Change in the Riff process won't go into effect until next contract negotiations
  - Student progress will be somewhere between 30%-50%
- Professional Growth next phase
  - o Presentation made in December and it is on the NUEA website
  - o Group is starting back up at end of month which is to:
    - Develop glossary & general implementation guide
    - Conduct sample focus groups to adjust model
    - Develop examples of various types of teachers and process
    - Develop cost structures
    - Develop proposal for cost
    - Develop implementation plan
  - o This is a negotiation item
