5. Evaluation Committee Report for 9/28 AR Meeting Agenda
 - The evaluation committee will be meeting on 9/23 and 9/24 to review professional learning on the student growth pilot. The committee will also be reviewing Illinois Administrative Code Part 50 to ensure that our evaluation process is compliant with the law.
 - On 9/30 and 10/1 the Committee will be visiting two districts; one that piloted Student learning Objectives and one that piloted Local Growth Model.
 - On 10/7 the committee will meet with District 203 teachers who participated in the student growth pilot last year. The objective of this meeting will be to obtain feedback from those teachers about the various student growth models they piloted last year.
